

# The Exodus Case

## *What archeological evidence supports the Biblical account of the Exodus?*

### *Clues:*

1. “And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the Lord caused the sea to go back...and made the sea dry land...” Exodus 14:21 (KJV)
2. “...the Lord...troubled...the Egyptians, and took off their chariot wheels...” Exodus 14:24-25 (KJV)
3. “And Mount Sinai was altogether in a smoke, because the Lord descended upon it in fire...” Exodus 19:18 (KJV)
4. “Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink.” Exodus 17:6 (KJV)
5. “...Moses...built an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars...” Exodus 24:4 (KJV)
6. “And he (Moses) took the calf which they had made, and burned it in the fire, and ground it to powder...” Exodus 32:20 (KJV)

## *Answers:*

1. An underwater land bridge on the Gulf of Aqaba, arm of the Red Sea
2. Coral-encrusted metal remains of Egyptian-style chariot wheels on the underwater land bridge
3. A blackened mountaintop in Midian beside a large plain that could have accommodated the Israelis
4. A split rock 60 feet high (with water erosion at its base) within view of the blackened mountain in Midian
5. An altar with the remains of 9 marble pillars at the foot of the blackened mountain in Midian
6. Remains of an altar to Egyptian-style cattle gods within view of the blackened mountain in Midian
